FAA TO HOLD VIRTUAL MEETING ON CHARITY FLYING RULE

The FAA's "virtual public meeting"—which is really nothing more than a weeklong Internet chat

session—on the agency's proposed charity/sightseeing rule will begin next Monday. The FAA is holding the chat session in lieu of real public meetings, despite calls from Congress and AOPA for the face-to-face sessions. The online meetings will run from 9 a.m. Eastern time on February 23 to 4:30 p.m. Eastern on March 5.
